



Why Can't I Skip My 20 Minutes of Reading Tonight?

Student "A" reads 20 minutes each day

3600 minutes in a school year

Student "B" reads 5 minutes each day

900 minutes in a school year

Student "C" reads 1 minute each day

180 minutes in a school year

1,800,000 words



90th percentile

282,000 words



50th percentile

8,000 words



10th percentile

By the end of 6th grade Student "A" will have read the equivalent of 60 whole school days. Student "B" will have read only 12 school days. Which student would you expect to have a better vocabulary? Which student would you expect to be more successful in school...and in life?

 - o ALL ONLINE
- REMAIN POSITIVE!!!!! FEAR AND DREAD DON'T HELP AT ALL!
- READ WITH YOUR CHILD,
 - QUESTION ABOUT THEIR READING.
 - o CITING EVIDENCE
 - IF YOUR CHILD SAYS, "I THINK FRANK WAS BRAVE.", ASK, "CAN YOU SHOW ME TWO PLACES IN THE BOOK WHERE IT SAID SOMETHING THAT MADE YOU THINK HE WAS BRAVE?
