# VOLUNTEER TUTORS NEEDED FOR 3 AFTER SCHOOL TUTORING PROGRAMS

## Tutoring at Chimacum, Port Townsend, and Quilcene School Districts

These tutoring programs provide math and reading support to students in 1st through 8th grades at Chimacum, students in 4th through 8th grade at Blue Heron Middle School, and students in Kindergarten through 8th grade in Quilcene. Chimacum students meet twice a week at the Chimacum campus. Port Townsend and Quilcene students meet once a week for two hours after early release Wednesdays. The program at Blue Heron has 1 hour of tutoring followed by 1 hour of enrichment activities. YMCA staff and volunteers provide a healthy snack before setting students up with academic activities, including one on one time with a tutor and time for educational games in a group setting.

- YMCA staff are recruiting volunteer tutors NOW for these programs. We need more volunteers in order to move students from the waiting lists to the programs.
- Tutors will receive orientation before starting.
- Our goal is to provide one on one support for each child, needing 5 or more volunteers per site.
- Educational materials, academic supplies, and snacks are supplied by the YMCA staff.
