YOU DID WHAT IN THE DITCH?

In the history of the American woman, arguably, the iconic symbol is the quilt. There has been significant research in the history of the quilt and how it was used in American culture. Using the methodology of the folklorist, which he is, did extensive fieldwork with quilters. Through questionnaires, dozens of interviews, serving as a judge at quilt shows, producing quilt shows, and most importantly, establishing a research archive for scholars and collectors to investigate the lore of the American quilter. It was very clear to Dr. Oldani how passionate women were in their dedication to quilting and never forgetting their fore mothers who preserved as they quilted.
