- 4. When the amount due is displayed, scan the bar code on the front of the permit with the scanner on the exit column; exit gate opens.

Garage parking fees are charged to the organization issuing the permit.

This permit may not be used by Miami University students or employees. Students and employees must purchase the parking privileges they are eligible for and park according to them.
