

This Summer... Explore Canada's Northeast

The rugged Atlantic Provinces are comprised of Nova Scotia, Prince Edward Island, New Brunswick and Newfoundland Labrador stand united by their proud maritime heritage.

There's no quick and easy way to explore this vast wilderness area and pay homage to the great Norse gods that forged it. Drive less and see more by RV, bus, boat and ferry to explore the mighty Northeastern corner of Canada and do it justice -- 2,132 miles in 32 days to be exact, on Fantasy's fabulous 2016 Atlantic Provinces tour, August 7 – September 7 – the very best time of year!

Rendezvous in Bar Harbor, Maine before heading to the natural beauty of St. Andrews and St. John, New Brunswick (NB.) A Low Tide drive across a sandbar to Ministers Island is a unique tour highlight, along with the geologic wonders of the Reversing Falls and Flowerpot Rocks. At Hopewell Cape, you will walk the ocean floor, later to return to see the world's highest tides arrive and cover your footsteps, and then witness the mighty Tidal Bore in the dense woods of Elm River, Nova Scotia, (NS).

Begin an 11-day Nova Scotia "New Scotland" adventure in the dense woods of Elm River, as you witness the mighty mystery of the Tidal Bore. NS features oceanview camping and a city tour in Annapolis Royal, a city tour of

Halifax, maritime museums and historic sites galore, and hopefully sightings of the fast-flying resident "sea parrot" or puffin. A must-see option is the Peggy's Point Cove lighthouse.

A famous ferry ride takes you to Port aux Basque, at the extreme southeasternend of Newfoundland Labrador (NL). "Who Knit You?" is the question you'll be asked here. It means "Where Are You From?" The three maritime provinces of Nova Scotia, Prince Edward Island, and New Brunswick all

share a historical and cultural heritage, but NL remains fiercely independent and marches to the beat of a different drummer. They even have their own time zone! NL is known for friendly people, voted one of the Top 10 Friendliest Cultures in the world, a wicked sense of humor, and storytelling spun from a hearty English, Irish, French, and Aboriginal heritage. You're here for a local tradition...a Newfie "Screech-In," a ceremony involving a man kissing a fish, and Newfoundland Screech, a high-





alcohol rum – we will say no more! Then it's on to all things Viking in St. Anthony with a Great Viking Feast Dinner at Leifsburdir, the L'Anse aux Meadows Historic Site, and the Viking port of Norstead. A Bonne Bay boat tour and visit to Norris Pass in Rocky Harbor completes your NL interlude.

Ferry back to NS to visit the Fortress of Louisburg, the largest reconstruction project in North America, and the rugged coastal views along the Cabot Trail.

The final four days of your tour are in the paradise of the smallest province, Prince Edward Island (PEI). Tour the Anne of Green Gables Home, setting for L.M. Montgomery's beloved novel, Anne of Green Gables. Explore more of the breathtaking North Shore hugging the Atlantic with an authentic lobster fishing demo, and call in to Charlottetown, the vibrant seaside capital of PEI, famous for its exquisite landscaping, historic homes, and year-round festivals!

Quaint fishing villages, historic lighthouses dotting craggy coastlines, geologic phenomena, and the fresh and plentiful bounty of the sea (lobster, scallops, clams, and mussels, oh my!) await your arrival. This extended journey through the great Canadian Northeast reveals a land of culture and history, a place of pride, strength and character in the hallowed Viking grounds of North America.
