St. Clare's provides alternative housing for these children who are forced to reside in hospitals simply because they have no other place to go; not because of medical reasons.

The Twilight concert for Children with AIDS has raised more than \$600,000 over the last nineteen years--and has no overhead. Every dollar raised goes to St. Clare's. For the twentieth straight year, the concert will be held at our church on **Saturday, March 5<sup>th</sup>, 2016 from 5 to 7:30 P.M.** Our highly acclaimed folk, gospel, and soft rock concert consists of well-known artists from the area. The wide-ranging musical arrangement makes it entertaining for people of all ages. The concert is followed by an elegant reception made possible by local businesses and St. George's hospitality committee. More than 200 people attended last year's concert.
