

FATHER LOPEZ CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOL 2016 – 2017 Tuition Schedule

Standard Tuition Rate (non-parishioner)	\$10,800
Parish Member Tuition Rate	\$10,100

Parish Discount—In appreciation for services received from the Diocese of Orlando and from the local parishes, and in order to encourage greater participation at the parish level, families who receive the approval of their pastor are provided a parish discount of \$700 off the Standard Tuition Rate. To qualify for this discount, you must submit a Parish Verification Form for Catholic Families. We are bound to abide by the decision of your stated parish. If you do not list a parish in the Biographical Information section of the online application, the Standard Tuition Rate will automatically apply until we receive the Parish Verification Form for Catholic Families. Income-based Assistance—To help families with the cost of a Father Lopez education, income-based assistance is available. To be considered for this tuition assistance, families must first complete a FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment online at www.factstuitionaid.com. This will allow the school to verify the appropriate income level for each family.

Additional Financial Assistance—Families in need of additional financial assistance must complete the FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment at www.factstuitionaid.com. Parents with extenuating circumstances not adequately covered in their online application may elect to send a written, confidential summary of these circumstances directly to Dr. Michael J. Coury, the President of Father Lopez Catholic High School.

Additional Costs—There is an annual Enrollment Fee of \$350 (\$500 maximum for families with more than one child attending Lopez). Textbooks and school uniforms are additional expenses, too.

Partner School Principal's Choice Award—Two students from each of our partner schools are selected by their Principal for this award. The first student will be offered a \$1,000 annual award; the second student will be offered a \$500 annual award. The award will be provided during each of the four years the recipient is at Father Lopez. (Our partner schools are: All Souls Catholic School; Basilica School of St. Paul; Lourdes Academy; Sacred Heart Catholic School; St. Barnabas Episcopal School; St. Brendan Catholic School; and, St. Peter Catholic School.)

State Assistance Programs—Other assistance opportunities are available for qualified families through two different programs in the State of Florida. "Step Up for Students" provides assistance to students who come from low-income families. The "McKay Scholarships for Students with Disabilities Program" provides opportunities for students with special needs.
