#### **ABOUT DANCING GREEN WAVES**

There is a DGW Constitution that is required to be reviewed and signed at the beginning of the team season. This is an overview of items from it and what to expect if chosen to be on the team. Please read this information, as these are the expectations of each dancer and need to be fully considered before trying out and joining the team.

# **GENERAL INFORMATION, EXPECTATIONS AND GUIDELINES:**

- 1. All Dance team members must abide by the Father Lopez Catholic High School (FLCHS) Dancing Green Waves (DGW) Constitution.
- 2. All FLCHS school rules must be followed. Athletic participation requirements:
  - Must have at least a 2.0 GPA. Grades will be checked and are taken into consideration at all times, including auditions.
  - Must have a current physical exam on file before start of season.
  - Must complete all athletic participation forms required for all student athletes.

# 3. Practice/Attendance – ATTENDANCE IS CRITICAL!

- Members are expected to attend ALL practices, home football games, competitions, community
  performances, basketball game performances and any other planned activity of the team whether the
  dancer is dancing or not. Poor attendance will result in possible dismissal from the team.
- DGW practices are Monday and Wednesday 3:45 6 pm and Thursdays 2 4 pm. All practices are mandatory and dancers are not to miss or leave early unless excused by coach.
- Any time a dancer is late to school, leaves school early or is absent, they may not participate at practice; however, they are expected to be there unless excused by the coach.
- Any absence must be reported directly to the coach before practice, performance or activity. Failure to report
  the missing of any DGW activity will result in an unexcused absence. Three unexcused makes future
  participation on the team up for discussion. TWO WEEKS noticed is the recommended time frame to give
  coach notice for missing a practice or any other DGW activity.
- Because of the time and commitment required to be a member of the dance team, it will be difficult to
  participate in other school sports. Being a DGW is a yearlong seasonal commitment.
- It is understood that many students have part-time jobs, participate in church and community activities, and
  take dance classes. Scheduling must be worked out in advance and missing because of poor scheduling is
  not a valid excuse. Team members will not allow a job or any other activities (including studio dance
  activities) to interfere with any DGW practice, performance or activity. Multiple unexcused absences will
  result in a dancer's suspension or dismissal from the team.
- There will be additional practices on Fridays and/or Saturdays (mostly competition season). There will be advance notice for these practices.
- Coach will release schedules for all DGW commitments in advance in order to make scheduling other activities easier, such as doctors' appointments.
- Missing dance team practice and/or school (except for field trips, if known ahead of time) the day before or the day of a game will result in not performing. However, this member must still attend the event in uniform.
- Everyone must practice at outside of DGW practices. Inability to learn and perform a routine may result in an individual's not performing for that game. There will be auditions for performances.
  - \*\*\*We want our dancers to get the best high school experience and realize that schedule conflicts happen. Please let the coach know of ANY conflicts that occur so that we can work out any issues with both sides. Communication is key and needs to come from both parent(s)/guardian(s) and dancer!

# 4. Uniforms:

- Personal dance items such as shoes, tights, practice clothes, etc. are the responsibility of the dancer to
  acquire and have when needed. There will possibly be team practice clothes which dancers will be
  responsible for paying for.
- Uniforms will be checked out to dancers as they are needed or for the year. They are property of the team
  and must be returned when asked for. They are also NOT to be worn except when designated by the
  coach or has approval to do so outside of DGW use.
- Uniforms or props ruined, lost or stolen may have to be replaced by dancer at their own expense.

## 5. Fees:

- Team costs include such things as costumes, props, music, choreographers, camps/clinics, competition, travel and food. The cost varies from year to year and team to team. Students and parents need to help us raise this money in order to maintain the program.
- There will be a set amount for each dancer to bring in (through fundraising, parent contribution, etc.).
- There are fundraising programs set up to help raise funds. Full participation from every dancer is expected.

## 6. Conduct:

Members of the team must remember that they are directly representing DGW and FLCHS, not just
themselves. While a DGW, they must have proper conduct, attitude and attire, as they are a direct reflection
of our school, student body and team. Excessive absences, tardies, improper conduct on or off campus
behavior will be considered good cause for dismissal.

#### 7. Parent Involvement:

- Parent involvement is key to the success of our program. There are email updates sent to parents that often need response. It is imperative that parents read, respond (when necessary) and stay in contact with the coach.
- There are also times we need parent volunteers. Please let the coach know what you can do.
- All parents (and others who want to be involved) must go through a fingerprinting process in order to interact
  with the team. Further information is available, please ask coach.

#### IMPORTANT MANDATORY DATES TO CONSIDER

- Dance Clinic Fundraiser: June 6 10
- Dance Practice: June 13-16 TBD
- Summer Practices: June and August times and days TBD (we will take July off) \*\*This will be the last summer with a flexible practice schedule.
- Camp (if funds are raised): July 30 August 2
- Football Home Games: August November 2016
- Occasional Basketball Games: November 2016 February 2017
- Competition Season: January to March 2017
- Friday and Saturday practices (dates given weeks in advance)

#### **APPLICATION EXPECTATIONS**

- Academics: a 2.0 GPA is required to try out and needs to be maintained throughout the school year.
- Attendance: school and practice attendance is important.
- Skills: we look to see what your current skills are (as listed) as well as your ability to learn and adapt to a group. Many factors go into the decision of a dancer's placement and it is with the entire team in mind that we select this way.
- Parent Support: it is important that a parent and/or legal guardian sign application as verification of their support for possible selection to the dance team.
