Rabbi Aaron Goldscheider will be our guest speaker from Israel. He will be sharing insights from his recently published Haggadah "The Night That Unites" (Urim Press).

Before making aliyah to Israel, Rabbi Aaron Goldscheider served as the Rabbi of the historic Mount Kisco Hebrew Congregation in Westchester, NY and currently lives in Jerusalem. He works at Yeshiva University's Gruss campus in Jerusalem training rabbinical students preparing for outreach positions and teaches in the Kemach Institute.

His Haggadah "The Night That Unites" highlights the teachings of Rabbi Kook, Rabbi Soloveitchik and Rabbi Carlebach. The Haggadah sold out in its first printing in Israel and America. A Hebrew edition was published in Jerusalem this past year.

"The Night That Unites" also offers a special section of contemporary readings and stories related to the Land of Israel and the Holocaust. Suggested questions are offered as a way of encouraging and guiding discussion at the Seder that will enhance the Passover night experience, and illustrations depicting all 15 steps of the Seder are featured throughout.
