

The City of Lafayette's Economic Development Department, which manages the city's public art program, is currently seeking a qualified artist of team or artists working collaboratively to create a public art sculpture on Main Street, located at the corner of 7<sup>th</sup> and Main, near the front of 661 Main St.

The Main St sculpture is one of five projects in *Lafayette Arts-Center Stage*, a series of bicentennial themed public art installations funded as one project; all located on Main Street in Downtown Lafayette's arts and culture districts. The public art initiative is being paid in part by a \$50,000 Placebased Investment Fund Grant awarded through the Indiana State Office of Community and Rural Affairs (OCRA) and coincides with the state's bicentennial celebration. *Lafayette Art – Center Stage* theme is being used to highlight the community's past while creating a new sense of place by promoting the area as an arts and entertainment destination.

The site of the sculpture is in the Main Street Streetscape Ph 1 & 2 plan; a four million dollar project currently under construction in downtown Lafayette.

The budget available to the artist(s) for the sculpture is \$20,000. The design must be durable, suitable and acceptable for public display and viewing by citizens of all ages. The project must be completed and installed by 30 December 2016.
