- Applicants must have worked at their agency between 2-5 years, and have less than 10 years experience in the workforce.

 Baltimore, MD is mandatory. AJFCA will cover all costs while at Pearlstone (which includes meals & rooming) as well as reimburse up to \$600 per fellow in travel stipends. If travel costs exceed \$600 it is the-agency's responsibility to pay for the difference.
- Fellows must have the necessary technology in their office setting to participate in video conference calls, including a webcam and the support needed to troubleshoot related IT issues
- Participation in monthly webinars/group calls
- Completion of readings or assignments given to fellows between calls, including monthly evaluations and active participation on a group discussion board
