

# JRIDE



You Don't Have To Have The Keys To Enjoy The Ride.

J Ride provides safe, reliable, non-emergency transportation for Jewish adults age 60 plus and special needs adults.

We will pick up the rider at their home and drive them to:

- medical appointments
- pharmacy to pick-up prescriptions
- personal care appointments
- grocery store

To qualify participants must:

- be at least 60 years of age
- reside within the following zip codes: 77025, 77035, 77036, 77071, 77096, and 77401
- be affiliated with a local Jewish organization

Reservations can be made at least 24 hours before an appointment (or up to 6 months in advance).

The program is available Monday-Friday from 7:00 AM-4:00 PM. There is a fee for this service.

The enrollment packet must be completed before scheduling a ride. Download the packet at [erjchouston.org/jride](http://erjchouston.org/jride).

N4NN Has Officially Kicked Into Action!

More than 100 participants attended the "launch party" for the Neighbors4Neighbors Network on June 14th at the Godwin Park Recreation Center. Mayor Annise Parker and Council Member Ellen Cohen spoke to the need for new ways to help our older adults as they age. They both praised the "village" concept as an innovative tool for helping seniors age-in-place and building caring neighborhoods.



Mayor Parker congratulated N4NN and JFS for establishing Houston's first village and described her own efforts to care for her grandparents as they grew older and less independent. Council Member Cohen also congratulated N4NN and introduced her 100-year-old mother who still lives independently. In an adjoining room, information tables introduced guests to other partner agencies serving seniors including the Evelyn Rubenstein JCC JRide and some of their other senior programs, the Constables Office, and the City's Department of Neighborhoods Office of Persons with Disabilities and Citizens Assistance Office.



Also on hand were the leaders of proposed N4NN social and educational programs, including guided autobiography and legacy letter writing, Zentangle, Westbury Community Garden, and exercise classes.
