HB 0023 **Relating to Autism**

HB 0029 **Relating to Financial Literacy Instruction in Public Schools**

Financial Literacy Instruction in the Public Schools: Revises Next Generation Sunshine State Standards for financial literacy instruction; provides that credit requirements for high school graduation & standard diploma include separate course in financial literacy; requires DOE to work with nonprofit organizations to develop standards & curriculum & professional development guidelines for teaching financial literacy. HB 0041 **Relating to Hazardous Walking Conditions**

Hazardous Walking Conditions: Revises criteria that determine hazardous walking conditions for public school students; revises procedures for inspection & identification of hazardous conditions; authorizes district school superintendents to initiate formal request for correction of hazardous conditions; requires district school boards to provide transportation to students who would be subjected to hazardous conditions; requires state or local entities with jurisdiction over roads with

SB 0092 **Relating to High School Graduation Requirements**

High School Graduation Requirements; Revising the requirements for the Next Generation Sunshine State Standards to include standards for financial literacy; revising the required credits for a standard high school diploma to include one-half credit of instruction in personal financial literacy and money management and seven and one-half, rather than eight, credits of electives, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2015

SB 0094 **Relating to Closing the Gap Grant Program**

HB 0099 **Relating to Juvenile Civil Citations**

Juvenile Civil Citations: Authorizes law enforcement officer to issue warning to juvenile who admits having committed misdemeanor or to inform juvenile's parent or guardian of juvenile's infraction; requires law enforcement officer who does not exercise one of these options to issue civil citation or require participation in similar diversion program; provides that repeat misdemeanor offenders may participate in civil citation program or other similar diversion program; provides that, in exceptional situations, law enforcement officer may arrest first-time misdemeanor offender in interest of protecting public safety; requires written documentation if arrest made. HB 0151 **Relating to Sexual Cyberharassment**

Sexual Cyberharassment: Prohibits person from willfully & maliciously sexually cyberharassing another person; authorizes law enforcement officer to arrest, without warrant, person that he or she has probable cause to believe has committed sexual cyberharassment; authorizes search warrant to be issued in specified instances; provides civil remedies; provides exceptions; authorizes law enforcement officer to arrest, without warrant, person that he or she has probable cause to believe has committed sexual cyberharassment; provides exception to prohibition on search warrants being issued to search private dwellings. SB 0152 **Relating to Disability Awareness**

Relating to Literacy Jump Start Pilot Project HB 0153

Literacy Jump Start Pilot Project: Requires Office of Early Learning to establish pilot project in St. Lucie County to assist low-income, at-risk children in developing emergent literacy skills; requires OEL to select organization to implement pilot project; provides eligibility requirements for participation; requires background screening for childcare personnel; requires OEL to allocate funds for pilot project. Relating to Licenses to Carry Concealed Weapons or Firearms SB 0176

Licenses to Carry Concealed Weapons or Firearms; Deleting a provision prohibiting concealed carry licensees from openly carrying a handgun or carrying a concealed weapon or firearm into a college or university facility, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2015 3/17/2015 SENATE Now in Judiciary

HB 0177 **Relating to Persons with Developmental Disabilities**

Persons with Developmental Disabilities: Revises definition of term "developmental disability" to include Down syndrome: adds certain individuals whose parent or guardian is active-duty servicemember of United States Armed Forces or member of Florida National Guard who resides in state to wait list priority categories. Effective Date: July 1, 2015 3/16/2015 HOUSE Now in Health Care Appropriations Subcommittee

SB 0180 **Relating to School Safety**

School Safety; Permitting a school superintendent, with approval of the school board, to authorize a school safety designee to carry a concealed weapon or firearm on school property; requiring school boards to formulate policies and procedures for managing active-shooter and hostage situations; permitting district school boards to commission one or more school safety officers on each school campus, etc. APPROPRIATION: \$157,927.00 Effective Date: 7/1/2015

SB 0186 Relating to Malt Beverages

Malt Beverages; Authorizing the sale of malt beverages packaged in individual containers of certain sizes if they are filled at the point of sale by certain licenseholders; requiring each container to be imprinted or labeled with certain information, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2015 3/16/2015 SENATE Now in Fiscal Policy

SB 0190 Relating to Hospices

HB 0197 **Relating to Tracking Devices or Tracking Applications**

Relating to Diabetes Awareness Training for Law Enforcement Officers Narain Diabetes Awareness Training for Law Enforcement Officers: Designates act the "Arthur Green, Jr., Act"; requires FDLE to establish online continued employment training component relating to diabetic emergencies; specifies topics to be included; provides that completion of training may count towards continued employment instruction requirements. SB 0228 Relating to Online Voter Application

Online Voter Application; Requiring the Division of Elections of the Department of State to develop an online voter registration system; requiring the system to compare information submitted online with Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles records, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2015

Relating to Restitution HB 0235

Restitution: Requires child's parent or guardian, in addition to child, to make restitution for damage or loss caused by child's offense; provides for payment plans in certain circumstances; authorizes parent or guardian to be absolved of liability for restitution in certain circumstances; authorizes court to order both parents or guardians liable for child's restitution regardless of one parent having sole parental responsibility; specifies that DCF, foster parents, & specified agencies contracting with DCF are not guardians for purposes of restitution; removes duplicative provisions authorizing court to require parent or guardian to be responsible for any restitution ordered against child. SB 0320 Relating to Adoption and Foster Care
