HB 0001 Relating to Physician Admitting Privileges

Hill

Physician Admitting Privileges: Creates "Women's Health Protection Act"; requires that physicians performing or inducing termination of life procedure have admitting privileges at hospital within specified distance of location where procedure is performed or induced & provide certain health care services; specifies that violations by physicians are grounds for disciplinary action, to which penalties apply; defines term "termination of life." Effective Date: July 1, 2016

SB 0006 Relating to State Minimum Wage

Bullard

State Minimum Wage; Increasing the state minimum wage; prohibiting an employer from paying an employee at a rate less than the state minimum wage; removing the limitation restricting application of the state minimum wage only to individuals entitled to receive the federal minimum wage; deleting obsolete language, etc. Effective Date: 1/1/2017

HB 0009 Relating to Reentry into State by Certain Persons

Trujillo

Reentry into State by Certain Persons: Prohibits entry to, or presence within, the state of persons denied admission, excluded, deported, or removed unless U.S. Attorney General consents to admission or federal law does not require advance consent. Effective Date: October 1, 2016

HB 0011 Relating to Missing Persons with Special Needs

Porter

Missing Persons with Special Needs: Creates pilot project in specified counties to provide personal devices to aid search-and-rescue efforts for persons with special needs; provides for

administration of project; requires reports; provides for expiration; provides appropriation.

SB 0012 Relating to Mental Health And Substance Abuse Garcia

Mental Health and Substance Abuse; Including services provided to treatment-based mental health programs within case management funded from state revenues as an element of the state courts system; specifying certain persons who are prohibited from being appointed as a person's guardian advocate; authorizing county or circuit courts to enter ex parte orders for involuntary examinations; revising the criteria for involuntary admissions due to substance abuse or co-occurring mental health disorders, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2016

HB 0013 Relating to Criminal History Records of Minors Jones (M)

Criminal History Records of Minors: Reduces period for which criminal history records of certain minors must be retained before expungement. Effective Date: July 1, 2016

HB 0015 Relating to STEM Teacher Loan Forgiveness Program Narain

STEM Teacher Loan Forgiveness Program: Creates STEM Teacher Loan Forgiveness Program; provides for administration, funding, eligibility, use of funds, & rules for program. Effective Date: July 1, 2016

HB 0021 Relating to Legislative Apportionment Jenne

Legislative Apportionment & Congressional Redistricting: Creates independent commission on legislative apportionment & congressional redistricting; provides for purpose, duties, membership, & funding of commission; requires commission to employ professional staff, hold certain hearings, & transmit certain plans to Legislature for consideration; subjects commission to government-in-the-sunshine & financial disclosure requirements; prohibits persons not serving on or employed by commission from influencing or attempting to influence commission members & employees other than through prescribed processes; provides criminal penalties. Effective Date: July 1, 2016

HB 0027 Relating to Education Funding Beshears

Education Funding: Prohibits sparsity supplement allocation from decreasing more than specified percentage for school districts with certain population. Effective Date: July 1, 2016

HB 0037 Relating to Direct Primary Care Costello

Direct Primary Care: Specifies that a direct primary care agreement does not constitute insurance & provides criteria for such agreements. Effective Date: July 1, 2016

HB 0039 Relating to Insurance Coverage for State Officers Gaetz (M)

Insurance Coverage for State Officers: Restricts participation of state officers in certain state group insurance programs that provide benefits in excess of those offered to Medicaid recipients. Effective Date: July 1, 2016

HB 0041 Relating to Discharge of Firearms on Residential Property Combee

Discharge of Firearms on Residential Property: Prohibits recreational discharge of firearms in certain residential areas; provides criminal penalties; provides exceptions. Effective Date: upon becoming a law

HB 0043 Relating to Churches or Religious Organizations

Plakon

Churches or Religious Organizations: Provides that churches or religious organizations, related organizations, or certain individuals may not be required to solemnize any marriage or provide services, accommodations, facilities, goods, or privileges for related purposes if such action would violate sincerely held religious belief; prohibits certain legal actions, penalties, or governmental sanctions against such individuals or entities. Effective Date: July 1, 2016

HB 0045 Relating to Prohibited Discrimination

Raschein

Prohibited Discrimination: Creates "Florida Competitive Workforce Act"; prohibits discrimination based on sexual orientation & gender identity or expression; defines terms; provides exceptions for constitutionally protected free exercise of religion. Effective Date: July 1, 2016

HB 0049 Relating to Autism

Cruz

Autism: Requires physician to refer minor to appropriate specialist for screening for autism spectrum disorder under certain circumstances; requires certain insurers & HMOs to provide direct patient access to specialist for screening for, or evaluation or diagnosis of, autism spectrum disorder. Effective Date: July 1, 2016

HB 0059 Relating to Agritourism

Combee

Agritourism: Prohibits local government from enforcing local ordinance, regulation, rule, or policy that prohibits, restricts, regulates, or otherwise limits agritourism activity on land classified as agricultural land; specifies that prohibition does not apply to local regulation of substantial offsite impacts relating to such activities; revises definition of "agritourism activity" to include civic & ceremonial activities; provides conditions under which agritourism activities on farms or on lands classified as agricultural lands do not limit, restrict, or divest land of such classification. Effective Date: July 1, 2016

SB 0068 Relating to Licenses to Carry Concealed Weapons or Firearms

Criminal History Records of Minors; Reducing the period for which the criminal history records of certain minors must be retained before expunction, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2016

SB 0072 Relating to School Safety

Evers

School Safety; Redefining the term "school"; authorizing a school superintendent, with

approval of the school board, to authorize a school safety designee to carry a concealed weapon or firearm on school property; requiring the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission to develop a school safety program by a certain date; requiring that fingerprinting fees be borne by the school safety designee or the school; authorizing district school boards to commission one or more school safety officers on each school campus, etc. APPROPRIATION: \$157,927.00 Effective Date: 7/1/2016

HB 0083 Relating to Identification Cards and Driver Licenses Santiago

Identification Cards and Driver Licenses: Provides for person's status as lifetime freshwater fishing, saltwater fishing, hunting, or sportsman licensee, or boater safety identification cardholder, to be indicated on his or her identification card or driver license; prohibits person born after specified date from operating certain vessel unless such person has in his or her possession photographic identification & boater safety identification card or state-issued identification card or driver license; requires each recreational license & state-issued identification card or driver license indicating possession of recreational license to be in personal possession of person to whom such license is issued while person is taking, attempting to take, or possessing game, freshwater or saltwater fish, or fur-bearing animals. Effective Date: July 1, 2016

HB 0085 Relating to Recovery Care Services Fitzenhagen

Recovery Care Services: Includes recovery care centers as facilities licensed under ch. 395, F.S.; provides admission criteria for recovery care center; requires emergency care, transfer, & discharge protocols; authorizes AHCA to establish separate standards for recovery care centers for care & treatment of patients; directs agency to enforce special-occupancy provisions of Florida Building Code applicable to recovery care centers; provides applicability of Health Care Licensing Procedures Act; exempts recovery care centers from specified minimum licensure requirements. Effective Date: July 1, 2016

HB 0089 Relating to Florida Kidcare Program Diaz (J)

Florida Kidcare Program: Provides eligibility for optional payments for medical assistance & related services for certain lawfully residing children; clarifies that undocumented immigrants are excluded from eligibility for optional Medicaid payments or related services; provides appropriation. Effective Date: July 1, 2016

HB 0091 Relating to Severe Injuries Caused by Dogs Steube

Severe Injuries Caused by Dogs: Provides for discretionary, rather than mandatory, quarantine or impoundment of dogs that cause severe injuries to humans; revises hearing & final order procedures & related confinement requirements, for dangerous dog actions; specifies circumstances under which dangerous dog that has caused severe injuries to human may be euthanized; authorizes local governments to adopt certain ordinances pertaining to dogs that have bitten or attacked persons or domestic animals; exempts law enforcement dogs from dangerous dog law. Effective Date: upon becoming a law

SB 0096 Relating to High School Graduation Requirements Hukill

High School Graduation Requirements; Revising the requirements for the Next Generation Sunshine State Standards to include standards for financial literacy; revising the required

credits for a standard high school diploma to include one-half credit of instruction in personal financial literacy and money management and seven and one-half, rather than eight, credits of electives, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2016

HB 0103 Relating to Transactions in Fresh Produce Markets Fullwood

Transactions in Fresh Produce Markets: Authorizing certain owners and operators of farmers' markets, community farmers' markets, flea markets, and other open-air markets selling fresh produce to allow authorized Food and Nutrition Service groups, associations, and third-party organizations to operate electronic benefits transfer systems in such markets; providing restrictions on the use of Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program benefits in such markets, etc. Effective Date: July 1, 2016

SB 0104 Relating to Intimate Apparel Thompson

Intimate Apparel; Prohibiting retail stores from allowing a customer to try on intimate apparel in the store unless it is tried on over clothing or with a disposable shield; prohibiting a retail store from selling intimate apparel that has been tried on in violation of the prohibition, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2016

SB 0110 Relating to Churches or Religious Organizations Bean

Persons Subject to Final Deportation Orders; Prohibiting the presence within the state of persons subject to final deportation orders unless such orders have been stayed pending judicial review, etc. Effective Date: 10/1/2016

Children Unattended in Motor Vehicles: Provides immunity from civil liability or criminal prosecution for forcible entry into motor vehicle to remove minor in certain circumstances. Effective Date: July 1, 2016

HB 0125 Relating to High School Graduation Requirements Clarke-Reed

High School Graduation Requirements: Requires students to earn one-half credit in health education for high school graduation; authorizes waiver for students who request to take &

SB 0128 Relating to Services for Combat Veterans and Their Families Simpson

Services for Combat Veterans and Their Families; Defining the term “combat veteran”; requiring that the Department of Children and Families establish the Florida Combat Veterans’ Care Coordination Program to provide combat veterans and their families with behavioral health care referral and care coordination services; requiring that the department contract with managing entities to enter into agreements with Florida 211 Network participants for such services, etc. APPROPRIATION: \$2,000,155.00 Effective Date: 7/1/2016

HB 0129 Relating to Juvenile Justice Edwards

Juvenile Justice: Revises circumstances when state attorney may file information when child of certain age range commits or attempts to commit specified crimes; removes requirement that state attorney file information; prohibits transfer of child based on child's competency; requires DJJ to collect specified data; provides specified sanctions to which juvenile may be sentenced; prohibits sentence from exceeding maximum adult term; revises criteria in determining whether to impose juvenile or adult sanctions; requires adult court to enter order including specific findings of fact & reasons for its decision; requires court to consider reports; revises how child may be sanctioned; removes requirement to impose adult sanctions; requires court to explain basis for imposing adult sanctions; revises when juvenile sanctions may be imposed. SB 0132 Relating to Direct Primary Care Grimsley

Direct Primary Care; Specifying that a direct primary care agreement does not constitute insurance and is not subject to provisions relating to prepaid limited health service organizations and discount medical plan organizations, or any other chapter of the Florida Insurance Code; providing that certain certificates of authority and licenses are not required to market, sell, or offer to sell a direct primary care agreement, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2016

HB 0133 Relating to After-School Programs Pilon

Effective Date: upon becoming a law

SB 0138 Relating to Disability History and Awareness Instruction Ring

HB 0139 Relating to Dental Care

Cummings

Dental Care: Establishes joint local & state dental care access account initiative, subject to availability of funding; requires DOH to implement EBT system; authorizes DOH to transfer state funds remaining in closed account at specified time & return unspent funds from local sources; requires DEO to rank shortage & medically underserved areas; requires DOH to develop loan program in cooperation with certain dental colleges & Florida Dental Association; provides rulemaking authority. Effective Date: July 1, 2016

SB 0140 Relating to School Choice

Ring

School Choice; Requiring a charter school applicant to undergo background screening; requiring a charter school applicant to provide evidence of accreditation; expanding the factors for approval of a charter application to include documentation of adequate financial resources, certain applicant identifying information, disclosure of additional charter schools sponsored by such parties and the records of such schools, and the independent status of any management company or cooperative, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2016

HB 0141 Relating to National Statuary Hall

Diaz (J)

National Statuary Hall: Provides for replacement of statue of Dr. John Gorrie and statue of General Edmund Kirby Smith in National Statuary Hall of U.S. Capitol; provides for selection of prominent Florida citizen to be commemorated in National Statuary Hall; provides for selection of sculptor to design statue; provides for submission of state's request to U.S. Joint Committee on Library of Congress for approval to replace statue. Effective Date: upon becoming a law

SB 0142 Relating to Student Loans

Ring

Student Loans; Requiring the Justice Administrative Commission and the Office of the Attorney General to implement a student loan assistance program to assist a career assistant state attorney, assistant public defender, assistant attorney general, or assistant statewide prosecutor in the repayment of eligible student loans; establishing requirements for the administration of the program; requiring the administering body to make payments based on the length of employment of the eligible career attorney and the availability of funds, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2016

HB 0143 Relating to Disposable Plastic Bags

Richardson

Disposable Plastic Bags: Authorizes certain municipalities to establish pilot programs to regulate or ban disposable plastic bags; provides program criteria; provides for program expiration; directs participating municipalities to collect data & submit reports to municipal governing bodies & DEP; defines term "coastal community." Effective Date: upon becoming a law

SB 0144 Relating to Autism

Ring

Autism; Requiring a physician, to whom the parent or legal guardian of a minor reports observing symptoms of autism exhibited by the minor, to refer the minor to an appropriate specialist for screening for autism spectrum disorder under certain circumstances; authorizing the parent or legal guardian to have direct access to screening for, or evaluation or diagnosis of, autism spectrum disorder for a minor from the Early Steps program or another appropriate specialist in autism under certain circumstances, etc. Effective Date: Except as otherwise expressly provided in this act, this act shall take effect July 1, 2016

SB 0146 Relating to Federal Student Loan Default Rates

Ring

Federal Student Loan Default Rates; Requiring certain institutions to maintain a federal student loan cohort default rate below a specified percentage; revising the minimum standards the Commission for Independent Education must use to evaluate an institution for licensure to include the institution's federal student loan cohort default rate; requiring Florida College System institution performance funding for industry certifications to take into consideration an institution's federal student loan cohort default rate, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2016

HB 0147 Relating to Expunging Criminal History Records of Minors Latvala (C)

Expunging Criminal History Records of Minors: Provides for nonjudicial expunction of criminal history of offense after specified period for minor who is not serious or habitual juvenile offender; provides exception for specified minors to apply for expunction before attaining 21 years of age; establishes application process & requiring specified documentation be submitted; requiring sworn statement from applicant; eliminates deadline for submission of application by minor for prearrest or postarrest diversion expunction. Effective Date: July 1, 2016

SB 0148 Relating to Consumer Protection

Ring

Consumer Protection; Citing this act as "Terry's Law"; requiring retail sales establishments that sell goods to the public to grant a refund within a specified time for goods costing more than a specified amount if returned by a consumer who has been adjudicated incapacitated, is subject to a certain type of guardianship, or has a certain medical condition, if specified

requirements are satisfied; providing penalties for a violation of the requirements, etc.

SB 0150 Relating to Offenses by Illegal Immigrants

Hutson

Offenses by Illegal Immigrants; Requiring specified offenses to be reclassified if committed by an illegal immigrant; specifying the reclassification of these offenses and enhancement of the level of the ranking for purposes of sentencing, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2016

Healthy Food Financing Initiative: Directs DACS to establish program to provide financing to retailers to construct, rehabilitate, or expand grocery stores in underserved communities in low & moderate income areas; provides program, project, & applicant requirements; authorizes funds to be used for specified purposes; directs DACS to adopt rules & submit reports; provides that creation & implementation of program is contingent upon appropriations. Effective Date: July 1, 2016

SB 0158 Relating to Identification Cards and Driver Licenses
