

After School Activities – Course Descriptions  
Spring 2015

**All Around Crafting**

We will craft, draw, and paint different kinds of things. An example of this is origami. We will also create and craft a board game! Open to grades 1 – 4.

**Band Lessons with Krista Johnson**

Students in grades 5-8 may take lessons on a band instrument: flute, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet, trombone, or percussion. Students must purchase or rent instruments. Books will also need to be purchased. Cost is \$8 a week, \$56 for a session.

**Bike Repair**

Learn the basics of bike mechanics! Open to grades 5-8. There is a \$10 supply fee.

**Computer Club**

Learn about basic website coding, photoshop, and computer graphics in google docs. Make posters, layouts, magazines, and learn about anything that has to do with computers! Open to grades K-8.

**Concert Band with Krista Johnson**

Make some music in a school concert band! If you are in grades 5-8 and take private lessons elsewhere, come and participate in the band! Cost is \$5 per week, \$35 for a session.

**Craftstravaganza!**

Come explore the world of crafts! We can learn simple sewing, knitting and crochet, painting, sculpture, paper cutting, and whatever else strikes our fancy. Craft supplies needed (yarn, paint, paper, etc.)

**Crocheting Bags with Frau Schmitt**

Students will learn how to crochet bags this time around. There is a \$10 supply fee for yarn. You will need your own hooks: size 5mm (=H8). A hook set is recommended (5-8mm).

**Das Atelier (Freies Kunststudio/ Free art studio)**

Open art studio. Jacob Olson will teach some techniques such as painting, drawing and collage. No (artistic) rules!

**Double bass, violin, cello & guitar**

Mr. Schwalbach will teach private ½ hour lessons in double bass, violin, cello, or guitar. Students will learn technique, theory, and build repertoire in chosen instrument. **Drums and Beats**

Students will learn percussion instruments, body percussion and practice rhythm exercises. Open to grades 1 – 5.

**Folk Music and Simple Songs**

Students will learn simple songs of the past in English and in German. Singers, musicians and non-musicians of all levels welcome. We'll try to set up simple recordings to give to your family as gifts and maybe do a performance. Open to K-8.

**German Desserts**

Join us to make delicious German desserts! Come bake with us! Open to 1-8 graders.

**Green Team**

We're saving the planet one project at a time. We introduced composting, expanded recycling and are planning an Earth Day Fest! All welcome!

**Gymnastics**

We will practice how to do a handstand, tumble, cartwheel and many other things. Open to 1<sup>st</sup> through 3<sup>rd</sup> grade.

**Junior Sport Games**

We want your children to get moving, to play and to have fun! Open to grades K & 1.

**Mädels: Munter mit Mut**

This activity is designed to instill girls with confidence and esteem by exploring all the things they CAN do. Each session will incorporate stretching, fitness (typically running), and a calming activity. Each week we will explore a different mind-body topic, such as: positive body image; making nutritious snacks; understanding and expressing feelings; expressing individuality what it means to be a good friend/family member; and how to navigate a world of media with mixed messages.

Girls should have leggings or sweatpants, running shoes, and socks for each session. A yoga mat or towel is also recommended. Open to girls only, grades 2-5.

**Mime and Movement**

Explore the world around you aided only with imagination. We will learn self-control and awareness while mastering classic mime skills and testing our improve skills. All welcome!

**Piano with Herbert Engelmayer**

Mr. Engelmayer will teach private ½ hour lessons in piano/keyboard lessons for students in Kindergarten and up. Students will learn basics of theory, technique, and build repertoire. Lessons taught in German. Students must purchase lesson books, an assignment book, and a three-ring binder. Fee includes end-of-school recital. We'll be expressive! Find forms in our random marks of color, while trying to minimize other marks we make through painting, drawing, experimenting on recycled materials, creating nature art, and learning how to use less! There is a \$10 material fee; open to K-5.

**Teal Sea Student Magazine with Thomas Wegener, Ben Schneider and William Blackwell Kinney**

In this activity, we will make a "magazine" offering all types of literature: fiction, nonfiction, poetry, and visual art, in both English and German. The magazine will be on a Google Doc, enabling kids to access the magazine and edit it whenever they want. The kids will use their Chromebooks in the class and will write and draw the whole time with supervision from Herr Wegener and our student co-editors, Ben Schneider and William Blackwell-Kinney.
