Housing Rehabilitation Program Helps Homeowners with Home Repairs

EASTHAM - The Community Development Partnership (CDP) has opportunities available to fund housing rehabilitation in the towns of **Dennis, Harwich, Eastham, Wellfleet, Truro, and Provincetown.**

Funds up to \$35,000 are available to eligible residents to pay for critical home repairs, like:

- Roofing and Siding
- Electrical
- Heating and Plumbing Work
- Structural Repairs
- Lead Paint Abatement
- Energy Efficiency Upgrades, such as windows and storm doors

The CDP staff works with the homeowners through every step of the process, from planning the work to completion. Program contractors are licensed and insured. Funding is limited and available on a first come first serve basis.

“The Housing Rehabilitation is a vital program for our community,” said CDP Executive Director, Jay Coburn. “Not only does it help to preserve the homes of eligible year-round residents, it also stimulates the local economy. Grant funds for the rehabilitation work are used to pay local contractors, their crew, sub-contractors and suppliers. Contractors are critical to the success of the program. We encourage interested parties to get in touch to find out more about this great opportunity.”
