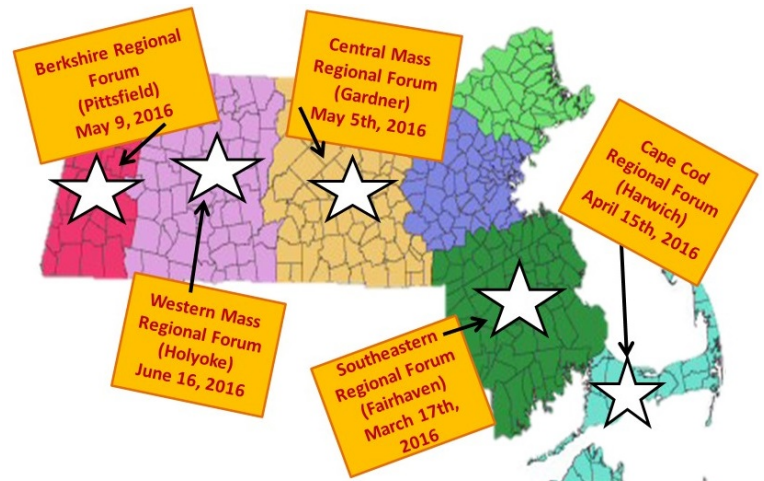
Palliative Care in the Context of Comprehensive Cancer Care, Access and Health Equity
