- To submit your application to Washington State PTA, please follow ALL directions. Applications not meeting the qualifications will be disqualified.
- Application Cover Sheet must either be hand written neatly in blue or black ink or electronically completed.
- Selection Criteria Narratives must be typed, standard 12 point or larger, on white 8.5x11 paper, and be no longer than three (3) pages.
- Two letters of recommendation are required. *One letter must come from a teacher, principal or guidance counselor. One letter must come from someone you have worked for in a volunteer capacity. **Both letters must be mailed to our office in a sealed envelope, or emailed from the email address of the person writing the recommendation.***

- **The application deadline is April 30, 2015. This is a DUE BY date, and not a postmarked by date. Scholarships will be awarded by June 15, 2015.**
