The Presidential Precinct is a consortium among two of America's premier universities, the University of Virginia and William & Mary; William Short's Morven, and the home of three Founding Fathers: Thomas Jefferson's Monticello, James Madison's Montpelier, and James Monroe's Ash-Lawn Highland. The Presidential Precinct aims to empower the next generation of influential leaders through education, collaboration, and digital networking.
