The **Resource Center for the Teaching of Italian at UCLA** is funded by the Consulate General of Italy in Los Angeles in collaboration with Fondazione Italia, a California non-profit organization. The Resource Center is housed in the UCLA Center for World Languages and offers a comprehensive library dedicated to supporting and enriching the teaching of the Italian language and culture at the K-16 levels. The Resource Center provides a wide selection of textbooks, workbooks, readers, grammar books, dictionaries, games, audio tapes, music CDs, as well as DVDs. Membership to the Resource Center is free and items are shipped free of charge to eligible members. Eligible members are educators, teachers and graduate students of Italian residing in California, Nevada, Arizona and New Mexico. Shipping charges apply to residents of other states.

Members agree to abide by the following terms:

- Up to ten (10) items may be borrowed at a time.
- Items may be kept for up to three (3) months with possible renewal for another loan period if the items have not been recalled.
- Items may be renewed via e-mail.
- Requested items are shipped free of charge and eligible members may request a pre-paid label to return borrowed items to the Center.

Your signature acknowledges your shared responsibility for proper care and timely return of all materials borrowed. In addition, you agree to replace any book that is lost or damaged while checked out. Lost or damaged books may be replaced by delivering a new book of the same title and equal binding quality to the Resource Center, or by payment of the replacement cost of the book.

We realize that accidents do happen; however, borrowing privileges may be revoked for any person who loses or damages more than two books per year. So, please make sure that all borrowed material is returned in good condition.
