

2016 Student Scholarship Application Introduction and Important Dates of the Program

January 25, 2016

Dear Student:

The Lake Washington PTSA Council is again accepting applications for its annual scholarship awards. The purpose of these scholarships is to provide recognition of overall achievement and community service by awarding monetary assistance toward the further education of selected graduating seniors from our LWSD High Schools - Eastlake, Juanita, Lake Washington, Redmond, Emerson, ICS, and Tesla STEM.

All student scholarships are \$1,000.00 and will be awarded as follows:

Qualification based on achievement and community service only

- One scholarship to the top candidate at each of the 7 LWSD high schools (7 awards)
- A minimum of three at-large scholarships selected from all of the remaining applicants

Additional qualifications required

- The Dr. L.E. Scarr Scholarship awarded to a student who will attend a vocational/technical school or community college
- The LWEA/Karen Bates Scholarship for a student pursuing an education degree
- The Jane Wierenga Memorial Scholarship for a student pursuing an education degree
- The Victoria Findley Scholarship for a student pursuing a degree in the field of health services such as Nursing, Public Health, or Health Informatics

In the event a recipient has not used the scholarship money at a college, university, or vocational school of his/her choice by January 31, 2017, the PTSA Scholarship award amount will remain in the LWPTSA Council Scholarship fund. If unusual circumstances prevent use of the award in the allotted time, you must contact the Lake Washington PTSA Council prior to January 31, 2017.

The LWPTSA Scholarship Committee has set the following timeline:

2016 – April 11 APPLICATION DEADLINE: All applications from students must meet the criteria

2016 – April to May Applications will be read and rated by the committee.

2016 – Mid-May High schools and recipients will be notified.

2016 – May to June Scholarships will be awarded at each high school's Spring Academic Awards

7pm, at the LWSD Resource Center and a reception prior to the meeting.

2016 Student Scholarship Application

The Lake Washington PTSA Scholarships are awarded to further the education of the chosen recipients and may only be used to pay for tuition, required textbooks, or room and board for on-campus housing.

The Scholarship Committee will award scholarships based on the following criteria:

- 1. Extra-curricular and community service activities.
- 2. Academic excellence and motivation.
- 3. Explanation of future goals.
- 4. Essay response quality of expressing yourself.
- 5. Character references.
- 6. Correct completion of the application, properly postmarked or delivered to the designated address by **the deadline of 6:00 PM on April 11, 2016.**

INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANT:

The following requirements must be met for your application to be accepted. Failure to follow instructions or submittal of incomplete applications will result in automatic disqualification.

- 1. Complete the main Application Form and all requested attachments, either typewritten or *legibly* printed.
- 2. Paper clip the following items to the *completed and signed* Application Form:
 - a. An official copy of your high school transcript that includes first semester grades of your senior year. An official transcript bears the signature and embossed seal of your school registrar. A progress report reflecting your first semester grades *does not* meet this criteria, nor do grade reports obtained online.
 - b. Two letters of recommendation. One should be from a faculty member at your high school. The other may be from an employer, family friend, or other appropriate individual. Letters of recommendation from members of your immediate family are not acceptable.
 - c. All pages containing your responses to the five (5) qualifications questions and one (1) of the essay questions listed on the main Application Form.
- 3. PAPER CLIP ALL attachments to the Application Form. DO NOT USE STAPLES.
- **4.** Include only that information specifically requested on the Application Form and these instructions. **DO NOT include notebooks, folders, portfolios, etc.**
- 5. Applications must be postmarked or delivered by 6:00PM, MONDAY, April 11, 2016.

NO APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THIS DATE!

APPLICATIONS NOT MAILED OR DELIVERED PROPERLY AND ON TIME WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
