

EASTLAKE HIGH SCHOOL REGISTRATION 2016-2017

We are gearing up for Eastlake High School registration for school year 2016-2017! We are excited to be using the Career Cruising platform for registration this year. It is very intuitive and user friendly. All registration materials including the Eastlake High School Course Catalog will be posted on Haiku and the EHS website. Most communication about registration will come to parents through electronic newsletters so make sure to watch for those.

Current middle school 8th graders:

There will be an informative parent night for Incoming 9th grade Parents on Wednesday, January 27th at 7:00 pm in the EHS theater. Please plan to attend that. Registration will be presented to students at Inglewood MS, Evergreen MS and Redmond MS/Quest during the week of February 1st in their LA/SS class. Eighth graders will come home that week with registration materials. The following week, counselors will return to the middle schools and guide students through entering their registration choices in Career Cruising. Choice middle schools (Environmental, Northstar, and Stella Schola) and private school eighth graders will have two registration sessions to choose from, Wednesdays February 3rd or 10th at 2:00 in the Eastlake HS Career Center. If you have questions about registration please see the EHS website, Eastlake HS Course Catalog, or ask your middle school counselor.

Save the Date: On April 26th from 6-8 pm Eastlake HS will be hosting a "Welcome to the Pack" event for incoming 9th graders. There will be tours of the school, showcases of EHS clubs, activities and athletics as well as teachers available to answer academic questions. Hope to see you there!

Current Eastlake HS students:

February 18th - 29th: Current Eastlake students will receive information about registration in their homeroom. Counselors will be presenting to each grade in the theater during homeroom with details specific to their graduating class. They will complete a credit check and bring home registration materials to complete their registration in Career Cruising. Counselors will be available during homeroom on February 18th, 19th and 29th to answer registration questions. Counselors will have drop in sessions for students with registration questions on Wednesday, February 24th after school and during STP time on Thursday, February 25th.

Monday, February 29th: Students will turn in their registration print out with parent signature to their homeroom teacher.

Honors, AP, or UW College in the HS classes: Students may need to follow additional steps for pre-requisites in applying for those classes. Some examples include an interview with the teacher, a writing sample, application with current teacher's recommendation. There will be an AP/UW Night on February 18th at 7:00 pm in the EHS Theater to find out information about pre-requisites, homework load and expectations. We highly recommend both you and your student attend if they are considering an AP or UW class.

Electives Fair: during Homeroom on February 9th so that students can find out more information about their elective options.

Running Start: If your student is interested in Running Start they still need to follow the EHS registration timeline/procedure and register for 6 classes here. There will be a Running Start Information Session for students and parents on Wednesday, January 27th at 12:30 pm in the EHS Theater for students to get more information about Running Start and how to apply. They can also find out information on the Bellevue College Running Start website.

As this is a very busy time registering 1600+ students, there will not be individual registration appointments with counselors. Students and parents should do their best on registration using the information provided in presentations and posted on-line. After registration if you feel there is an extenuating circumstance please e-mail your counselor and they will help you to make any changes determined necessary.
