All student scholarships are \$1,000.00 and will be awarded as follows:

Qualification based on achievement and community service only

- One scholarship to the top candidate at each of the 7 LWSD high schools (7 awards)
- A minimum of three at-large scholarships selected from all of the remaining applicants

Additional qualifications required

- The Dr. L.E. Scarr Scholarship awarded to a student who will attend a vocational/technical school or community college
- The LWEA/Karen Bates Scholarship for a student pursuing an education degree
- The Jane Wierenga Memorial Scholarship for a student pursuing an education degree
- The Victoria Findley Scholarship for a student pursuing a degree in the field of health services such as Nursing, Public Health, or Health Informatics

Staff scholarships are \$500.00 each. A minimum of two (2) scholarships will be awarded.

Student scholarship applications are now available in the Career Centers or counseling offices at each high school.
