WATCH AND LEARN

WHAT is Watch and Learn?

- Educational program where attendees view actual criminal or civil docket in Ingham County.
- Opportunity to ask questions of the Circuit Court Judge after the docket concludes.
- No prior knowledge is required to attend. Information will be sent out to review the day before and practitioners will be present to answer simple procedural or legal questions.

WHEN is Watch and Learn?

- Watch and Learns, previous called Motion Call Wednesdays, are held approximately once per month and alternate between the civil and criminal docket per judge.
- The next Watch and Learn is **Wednesday, March 23, 2016, 1:15PM-4:30PM.**
- This month's host is the **Honorable Judge James Jamo** for his **afternoon civil docket.**
- You do not have to be able to attend the whole time to attend a portion of the Watch and Learn.
