We will focus on the basics of light and color as we explore different landscapes through photographs and en plein air. Study the work of the impressionists and other masters, and learn how to use a variety of techniques to produce a luminous pastel painting.

**Myths and Magic** 11-15 yrs. August 22-26 1-4 p.m. \$210

In this class, you'll learn the art of storytelling from ancient and modern myths and you'll design, write and illustrate your very own book!

# Week-Long Intensives for Teens & Adults

Wheel Throwing Intensive 15+ yrs. July 11-15 9 a.m.-noon \$220

In this week-long class we'll explore various techniques on the potter's wheel and focus on the art of making containers and vessels. Surface design, such as glazing, carving and sgraffito will also be taught, and you'll be encouraged to individualize the cups, bowls, vases and plates you create.

Jewelry Making: Rings and Charms 15+ yrs. July 11-15 1-4 p.m. \$230

Learn the creative possibilities of the lost-wax casting technique, a process that has been used to make jewelry and sculpture for thousands of years! You'll be able to carve, cast and finish at least one metal ring or charm in silver. Think it, create it, have fun! Materials provided.

Pottery- On and Off The Wheel 15+ yrs. July 18-22 9 a.m.-noon \$220

Immerse yourself in a clay experience! This week will be a combination of wheel-throwing, slip-casting and hand-building, and you'll be encouraged to experiment with altering and manipulating some of the clay forms you've thrown. You'll be wedging, centering, trimming, rolling, sculpting and glazing.
