Was that a bell I just heard? Mystical, magical, mysterious and imaginative animals and beings will come alive because you make them so during this week of creative drawing, painting, sculpting and art-making!

You'll be guided through the fundamentals, and draw from observation and imagination using the principles of line, value, form and composition. Rules of perspective will also be explored. Drawing media include graphite, conté crayon, pastel and charcoal.

Students will experience working on the wheel as well as sculpting and hand-building. Projects will include making different types of pottery, such as cups, bowls and plates, with decorative motifs focusing on flowers and plants. Projects will be glazed and fired.

The afternoon Clay Sampler session will follow the format of the morning session, but the focus of the decorative motifs and sculpture will be birds and beasts. Photography: Black & White and Alternative Processes

Learn the basics of traditional black and white photography in this introductory course for high school students. Then take it one step further and learn about printing your images on “non-traditional” surfaces or alternate printing materials. Rental cameras are available upon request for an additional \$15.

Sculpture, Mixed Media and 3-D Collage

We will create functional objects with the potter's wheel and mixed media sculpture using alternative methods. Materials will include clay, wood, wire, found objects, fabric and plaster.

The Architect's Eye

The Zimmerman House designed by famous American Architect Frank Lloyd Wright, is a jewel in the Currier's collection. Draw the house and gardens and create your own scale model of the house!

Portfolio Boot Camp

This week-long class is for young artists aiming to create competitive portfolios for art school and college admissions. The week will include hands-on work from observation, figure drawing and more.

Weaving the Functional Vessel: Baskets

In this class, join basket weaver and artist Meagan Snavelly as she teaches you how to bend, dye and weave reeds and other materials to create baskets that are as unique as the individuals who make them!

Intro. to Jewelry Making

Learn the fundamental skills to create beautiful silver jewelry. You'll have the opportunity to create rings, necklaces, earrings and chains. \$40 materials fee is included in the price of this class.

Clay Sampler

This is the more advanced version of the Middle School Clay Sampler Intensive. The week will include working on the wheel, sculpting, hand-building (coils, slabs and pinching) and using the extruder.
