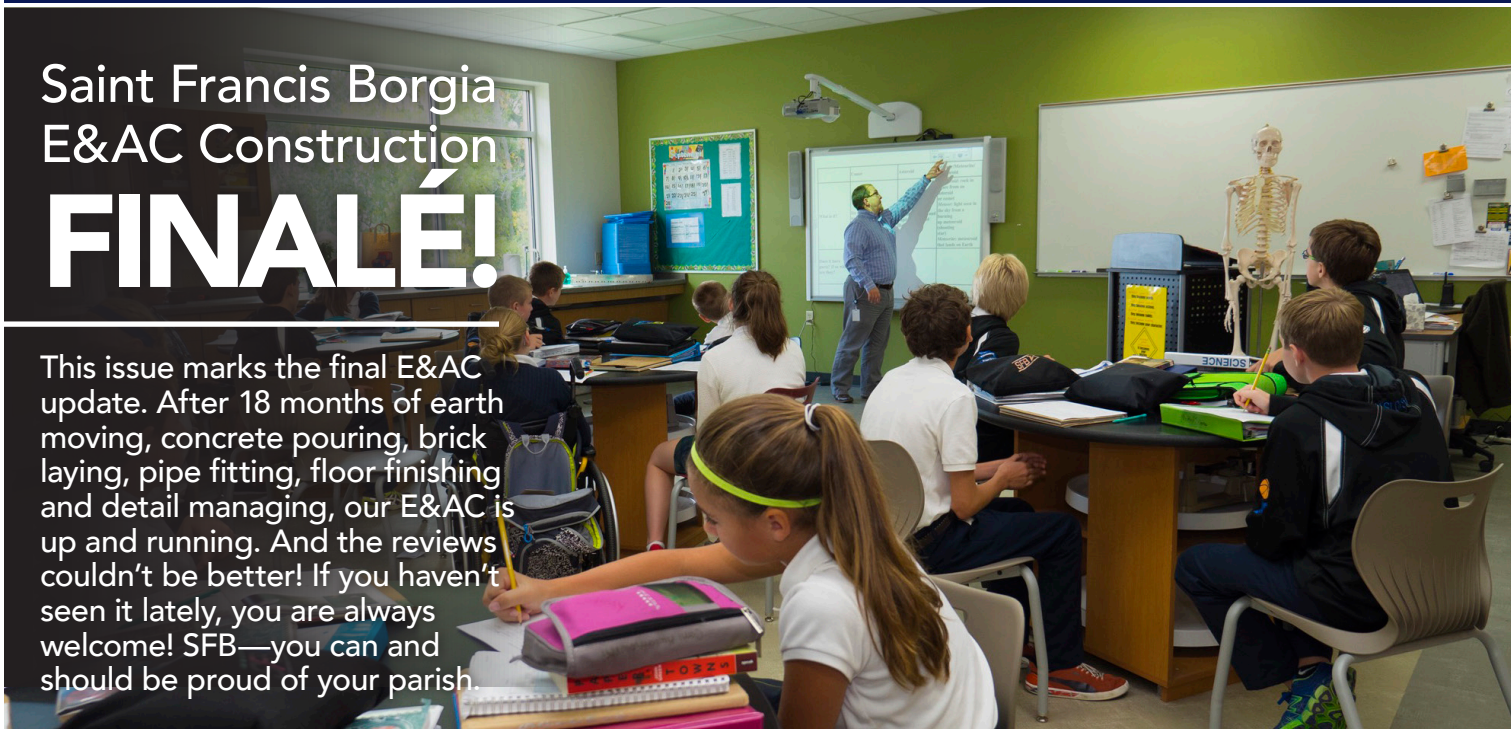


Saint Francis Borgia E&AC Construction **FINALE!**
