# **CTH NN Reconstruction through Walworth County Government Campus to Begin Soon !!!**

At its March meeting, the County Public Works Committee awarded the CTH NN Reconstruction contract to Payne & Dolan in the amount of \$2,477,411.

This project includes lane expansion (creating a center, two-way left hand turn lane) and will upgrade the road from a rural to an urban section (curb/ gutter, sidewalk and terrace trees) on the County Government campus sec-


**Lake Beulah Dam Project** To Close CTH J for Several Months

## **Wisconsin Department of Transport County Highway Updates**



### Work on I-43 43 Commencing in Walworth County



Beginning on March 27th, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) has recommenced work on I-43, from US 12 to WIS 83, in Walworth and Waukesha Counties. A single lane closure on I-43 (southbound) has already begun. A short term closure of the WIS 83

(southbound) on-ramp to I-43 is scheduled for mid-May. Major earth moving operations are scheduled to begin the first week of April.

The contractor, Payne and Dolan, plans on completing the project in late spring. The schedule is weather permitting and subject to

#### 2014 work completed

- Repaved the roadway south of WIS 83
- Rebuilt the Canadian National Railroad
- Replaced foundational bearing on 11 bridges along the corridor

#### 2015 work to be completed

- Finishing work on the 11 repaired bridges including painting and slope paving
- Removing median pavement that was part of 2014 traffic crossover
- Completing paving on WIS 83 (southbound) on-ramp to I-43

## WisDOT Schedules CTH A / STH 89 Intersection Improvements



In an effort to address some recent accidents at the CTH A/STH 89 intersection in the Town of Richmond, the Wisconsin Department of Transport is making several improvements to the intersection in the next several months.



New flashing beacons above the stop signs will be installed and the stop bars will be moved closer to the intersection to im-

prove visibility. In addition, the County will be installing additional stop ahead signs on CTH A.

#### **Venture Architects to Work** with County on Small Projects

Venture Architects, a Milwaukee-based architectural design and engineering services firm, was recently selected from among 18 firms who submitted their qualifications, to provide needed services to Walworth County on small facility remodeling and improvement projects that are under \$500,000 in estimated construction cost. Venture has a strong interdisciplinary team that has worked with 37 of the 72 Wisconsin counties on various building projects.

Venture will begin to work immediately with county staff on a variety of 2015 Capital Improvement Projects including the remodeling of the Government Center basement; planning for the renovation of the Sheriff's Office Lobby; roof repairs at various county buildings and the installation of LED lighting at the Sheriff's Office as part of the County's energy efficiency efforts.
