<u>Background</u>: Volunteers from Albany County residents are striving working together to lower the cost of solar. Since the Fall of 2014, your neighbors have been working meeting to select a solar installer that offers a quality solar installation at a bulk purchasing good price. That installer was recently chosen. Now we are gearing up to offer weekly education seminars to educate Albany County residents about solar, as well as to introduce the chosen installer.

The Solarize Albany campaign is Based on an approach developed by the Department of Energy (DOE) in 2007, supported by the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority (NYSERDA), and now being adopted by hundreds of communities around the Country, citizens work together to send out 'requests for proposals' to area solar installers, and then select an installer to work with. We do need a commercial installer to install solar, BUT this is not a commercial venture, although a commercial vendor does the installations. Rather it is a cooperative venture. Costs for solar installations come down because the purchasing is done on a bulk basis to bring down costs for the commercial vender/installer and the savings are passed on to the Solarize members who sign up with the installer for solar. In addition, volunteers help people to understand solar energy. Public presentations are being scheduled, where questions about solar energy are answered. At these presentations, the specifics of how to request a solar proposal for your home are shared.

Solarize campaigns also encourage neighbors to get to know one another. As individual homeowners install solar power, neighbors are inspired by their example. People talk together and learn from each other. Neighborhoods are strengthened.
