Sustainability is a way of life here at Stanford, and as building managers, you can have a significant influence on the environmental impact of our daily operations. Office of Sustainability (OOS), in partnership with Building & Grounds Maintenance, invites you to participate in a webinar to learn about some of the targeted approaches to saving energy this year through its Cardinal Green Buildings campaign. The campaign also includes details about Winter Closure.

This year, in an effort to streamline the program, OOS will work with specific buildings and engage occupants in some new offerings, including a 'space heater swap' and an equipment timer program. Each year, the Cardinal Green Buildings Campaign results in an average of \$350,000 in avoided energy costs — which represents 1.5 million kilowatt-hours of electricity or 840 metric tons of CO2 emissions.
