Keynote Speaker Biography: Barry S. Levy, M.D., M.P.H.



Barry S. Levy, M.D., M.P.H., is a physician and epidemiologist who has spent much of his career in public health as an educator, researcher, clinician, consultant, program director, and organizational leader. He is an Adjunct Professor of Public Health at Tufts University School of Medicine and a consultant in occupational and environmental health. He has co-edited 18 books related to public health, including books on occupational and environmental health, and the relationship to public health of war, terrorism, and social injustice. He co-edited the recently published book *Climate Change and Public Health*. He has authored more than 200 journal articles and book chapters. He is a past president of the American Public Health Association and a recipient of its Sedgwick Memorial Medal. He is a long-time member of the Massachusetts Public Health Association.
