2016 Armada Fair 4H Youth Council Contract for

Pre-Fair and Fair Dates of August 14-21, 2016

4H Club Member/Leader/Volunteer Requirements:

Handle all items with care before and after the fair.

<u>Set up and clean up Barn #12</u> –Remove staples on risers, paper risers and tables. Clean glass cases and other displays. Sweep/vacuum floors. Set up Club displays. 4H to provide: Cleaning Supplies Office supplies: staples, staplers, pens, pencils, string, tape, markers, clips, peg board hooks, etc. Other supplies: nails, screws, extension cords, hammers, screw drivers, paper for covering tables, straight pins, etc.

Assist Judges on Sunday, August 14th – Each Club should be represented on this day, using the online sign-up program provided by the MSUE office. Help clerk, carry exhibits back to barns, and tag with appropriate ribbons. Be sure judge signs Department book, return judge's books to Fair Office.

Arrange Barn #12 – Be sure tags are unfolded so that names can be seen, clean rods before hanging quilts and pin to secure. Ribbons should all be visible on all items. Be sure tag and ribbons are visible such as on lower corner of quilts or on the front of picture frames. Arrange entries in the barns after judging is complete. Be sure all ribbons are on each item and clearly visible. Set up fencing to secure areas.

Check out – Sunday Aug 22nd: Assist collecting items for exhibitors. Match tag numbers to items. Perishables are to be tossed out. Attach ribbon to tags for pick up.

What will AAS provide during set up/clean up day:

Assistance during set up by either Fair Board or other designated by AAS committee Paper for covering tables
Drinking Water

4-H to provide during set up/cleanup day

Cleaning Supplies

Office supplies: staples, staplers, pens, pencils, string, tape, markers, clips, peg board hooks, etc. Other supplies: nails, screws, extension cords, hammers, screw drivers, straight pins, etc.

For Sunday judging, AAS will provide:

Judging sheets and pencils

Continental breakfast, coffee, juice and lunch for Judges and those persons who assist during judging.

ASSIST AT ALL 4H LIVESTOCK/DOGS SHOWS!-Please contact the Armada Fair and 4H Superintendents regarding specifics per show. Volunteers shall assist in clerking, passing out ribbons/trophies and manning all gates, most importantly the Horse Arena gates, and anything else required during the show. Clean-up on Sunday night is mandatory.
