#### **Guidelines for Sheep Show**

\*Sheep are to be inspected before unloading and must show no visible signs of illness, disease or external parasites

\*All sheep must have USDA Scrapie ID tags
\*All lambs must be shorn within 5 days of show
\*Market lamb classes must have a minimum of 5
lambs per class except the white face class.

\*Commercial Ewe Lamb class-A ewe lamb may be shown in either the market class or the commercial ewe lamb class-not in both

#### **Guidelines for Livestock Judging Clinic & Contest**

Junior Division-8 to 12 years of age

Intermediate-13 to 15 years of age
Senior Division-16 to 21 years of age
Livestock judging is the evaluation of an animal's characteristics and making a comparison to other animals and the ideal standard of that particular class. After evaluating each animal individually, a ranking is assigned to that class.

Youth will have the opportunity to learn by evaluating as a group two individuals. Then, the contest portion begins where youth will judge a class of four animals. Swine, Sheep and Goats will be part of the Clinic and Contest.

This is a great opportunity to try something new or improve your skills!

#### **Guidelines for All Shows**

\*Open to youth 8-21 years of age as of Jan. 1, 2015

\*All exhibitors must show their own animal

\*Michigan Only Show

\*Wood shavings only in pens

\*The show committee will clean all pens

\*Entry Fees are \$15 per head (\$20 after May 23rd)

\*Pen fees are \$10 (4 goats per pen, 2 hogs per pen, 4 sheep per pen)

\*Cash awards will be distributed the day of the show \*Entry forms must be postmarked by Saturday May 23, 2015. A \$5.00 late fee per animal after May 23rd.

\*Bedding is available to purchase the day of the show. All pens must be bedded with pine shavings \*Concessions will be available on site
