GENERAL ASSEMBLY CONVENES FOR SHORT SESSION:

The North Carolina General Assembly convened for the "short session" on Monday, April 25th. Sometimes the short session isn't so short, but this year they started a little earlier in hopes they could adjourn by July 4th. Typically the legislators stick to only issues that are money-related as the session is meant to tweak the budget that was approved last year. However, they can be quite creative in making sure some of the bills are related to the budget. They do try to stay away from controversial issues in the short session.

The deadline for submitting legislation is approaching, so the legislative staffs are hard at work. We are working on some fishing issues and watching for a net ban referendum that Rep. Billy Richardson has said publicly that he would introduce.
