# NCFA TAKES POSITION ON SOUTHERN FLOUNDER SUPPLEMENT AND LEGISLATIVE ISSUES:

**Logbook for Charter & Headboats** - A motion was made and seconded that: "The Marine Fisheries Commission may require logbooks for for-hire fishermen, and if it does, it shall require similar reporting measures for all recreational fishermen." The motion carried unanimously.(After a very long and spirited debate.)

Offshore Energy Development (Oil and Wind) - The board agreed by consensus not to be for or against either, but to participate in stakeholder and informational meetings to assure our concerns for environmental issues and spatial conflicts are addressed and to keep our options open for changes in our position as we learn more.

**Proposed Southern Flounder Supplement** - The board agreed by consensus to oppose the development of a supplement and request, if the commission takes any action, that it initiate an amendment.

**Core Sound Shellfish Lease Moratorium** - The board asked Jerry to talk to gather more information on the issue on the history of the moratorium and details about the current attitudes pro and con and bring it back for the next meeting.

**Appointments** - The board agreed by consensus to maintain its position that individuals should not serve concurrently on the Marine Fisheries Commission and federal councils. Also, the board agreed by consensus that at-large seats should not be removed from the Marine Fisheries Commission, but should be filled by individuals who do not qualify for other seats.
