March and April are the two biggest months for EWGA member renewals. If you're among the many EWGA'ers whose annual memberships are up in these two months, please don't forget to send in your dues to EWGA Headquarters.

You will be receiving – or have already received – emails and letters from Headquarters. I hope you have looked at them and plan to renew. Renewals are \$130 for a Classic Membership, \$100 for Seniors and \$75 for Young Professionals (ages 18-30). Your dues entitle you to EWGA National member benefits, as well as all the EWGA play and events offered by our local chapter.

If you are new to EWGA, now is a great time to join for the first time. If you do so at one of EWGA's upcoming events – including the Women's Night at Golfsmith on March 17 or our Kickoff at Charbonneau Golf Club on April 16 – you will receive a \$20-discount off a Classic Membership, making it just \$135 to join. (The discount does not apply to seniors or young professionals.)

Seniors still get a break with \$125 new Classic Memberships, while Young Professionals can join for the first time or renew for the same \$75 fee.

If you are a former EWGA member who has been gone a while and wants to rejoin, you can do so at the renewal fee of \$130, instead of the full Classic fee of \$155.
