We've all heard the urban legends: Walt Disney is cryogenically frozen, Elvis is alive and well and living in Eastmoreland and the Claremont Golf Course is a short, Executive Par-3 course.

Well, Walt Disney was cremated, Elvis is actually living in Phoenix and Claremont Golf Course is not a short par-3 course.

Yes, Claremont only has nine holes but it is 2,696 yards from the red tees and the rating is 115. Compare this to the front nine at RedTail, at 2,735 yards and 129 or the front nine on the East Course at Glendoveer, which is 2,360 yards and 108.

Find out for yourself and play in the Claremont Morning League. Play will be Thursdays, July 7, 14 and 21, and Wednesday, July 26. The cost (walking) is \$64 for all four weeks for those age 60 and over, and \$80 for those under 60. The two-week cost is \$34 and \$42, respectively.
