


What is Multiple Sclerosis?



“**Multiple Sclerosis (MS)** is a disease of autoimmunity and inflammation characterized by destruction of the **myelin sheath** that insulates and protects neurons. A person can contract Multiple Sclerosis or MS both genetically and/or through the environment. One major factor in MS is the amount of evidence that suggests a lack of Vitamin D in people who suffer from this disease. - Weakness in extremities
- Double vision
- Overall eye discomfort
- Difficulty speaking
