By meeting these requirements on the due dates specified, you'll not only remain a PTA unit in good standing, but your unit will also be eligible for awards and participation in the Reflections and Scholarship programs. The IRS can impose fines and penalties for those group(s) or individuals that do not comply with their annual filing requirements, regardless of whether they have a parent organization or not. Numerous units have been able to refute an IRS fine or penalty because the Florida PTA office was able to produce the required document(s) that a local unit was unable to locate.
