All Childhood vaccines birth – 18 years;
Adult vaccines - Flu and shingles.

Documents to bring with you:

If available, a record of vaccines the
child has already received
Health insurance card
If applicable, cash or check to pay for
pediatric and adult vaccines
If applicable, cash or check to pay for
Flu vaccines which are \$20

NOTE: For pediatric clients, services
will not be denied for an inability to
pay for pediatric vaccines

Documents to bring with you:

Must have Valid State of Michigan Photo ID

based on their geographic location and need.

Veteran Services

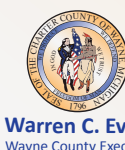
Provide potential grants for emergency
needs (i.e. shut off notice DTE bills, past due
rent, past due mortgage payments);
Apply to receive financial assistance in paying
for funeral expenses for Wayne County Veterans.

Documents to bring with you:

DD-214 (Military Discharge) or service letter
Valid State of Michigan Photo ID
Verification of income and expenses
Utility Shut-Off Notice
Foreclosure notice
Eviction Notice
Marriage License
Birth Certificate or Proof of Legal
Guardianship for minor children

For Deceased Veterans also bring:

Death Certificate
Itemized Funeral Bill, if applying for burial
reimbursement
