




OFFICE









CONCEPT ILLUSTRATION










PROJECT MANAGEMENT





ENGINEERING

WallGoldfinger's experienced engineers create detailed Solidworks drawings that, after approval by clients, woodworkers use to build the furniture exactly as the drawings specify.












WOODWORKING

techniques.




















VENEER

The veneer department uses thin slices of tree species from around the world to create beautiful patterns that are glued together and then glued atop core materials to create stunning surfaces. All veneer work is done in-house by a professional team in a moisture-controlled environment, and then sanded and finished to perfection.











CNC

Two high-tech computer numerical controlled routers allow detailed cutting of custom shapes, such as curved edges and cut-outs for technology.
















FINISHING

Veneer and more is finished to perfection through the use of stains, sealers and toners as well as catalyzed lacquer, urethane and polyester top coats in a spacious department. Four spray booths provide state-of-the art ventilation.











REASSEMBLY

After finishing, furniture is reassembled prior to shipping to ensure the fit and function meets WallGoldfinger's high standards for excellence.













SHIPPING

Furniture leaves the factory bound for points across the country. The shipping department ensures not only safe delivery but that shipping containers and trucks accommodate city loading docks, elevators and more.
