Choose one (1) item from each category

Proof of Authorization to Work in the US—birth certificate, passport, voter registration card, INS card, or permanent residency card

Proof of Residency—drivers license, utility bill, rent receipts/shelter, or voter registration card

Proof of Social Security—SS card, SS admin letter, or public assistance record with SSN

User Name/Password — To save time, sign up or check your existing individual account on mwejobs.maryland.gov so you know your user name and password when you come to the Center
