



Shalom Reb Yosef,

The shiurim are going really well Baruch Hashem. People are enjoying it, are stimulated and interested. We have been using the format of me telling the story, guiding the discussion of what people think is right and wrong, I present the halachos, and go through the application. Many of the attendees don't read/understand hebrew well enough to follow the sources, and I think they enjoy the group discussion format because it is inclusive. As the group gets used to learning together they have gotten more comfortable sharing their opinions in public, which makes for much better discussion and argument.

Could you please send me a few more discussion topics. The guys love them. The best response has been from ones that have solid halacha coming out in the end.


