STEP 1: Go shopping for a backpack suitable for both boys and girls!

STEP 2: Fill the backpack with the following items (and more) for 3rd through 6th Grade

- [] 1 3-hole pencil pouch
- [] 1 Pack of latex-free #2 pencils (12-ct)
- [] 1 Pack of colored pencils, pre-sharpened
- [] 1 Pencil sharpener w/ receptacle
- [] 1 Pack of latex-free pink erasers (2-ct)
- [] 1 Red pen
- [] 1 Pack of thick markers (12-ct)
- [] 1 Pack of crayons (24-ct)
- [] 1 Pack of multi-colored highlighters (4-ct)
- [] 1 Bottle of glue (4-oz)
- [] 4 Glue sticks
- [] 1 Ruler (flexible) w/ both standard and metric markings
- [] 2 Packs of wide-ruled filler notebook paper (100-ct)
- [] 3 70-ct spiral notebooks, wide-ruled
- [] 4 Composition notebooks, wide-ruled
- [] 4 Folders w/ brads and pockets, assorted colors
