# About the Kentucky Transpark

The Kentucky Transpark has 500+/-acres available (900+/-acres total) of industrial land located on U.S. 31-W and Highway 68/80.

- Can accommodate heavy and light industrial manufacturing operations
- Immediate access to I-65 via connector road, currently under construction
- Top-quality education and training center on-site
- Received state and national recognition for excellence in economic development efforts and environmental protection
- 1 million gallon elevated water tank to directly serve the park
- New 40MW electric substation expandable to 80MW

**Speculative Building VI** will be a pre-engineered steel structure with insulated panels situated on 17+/- acres. The building will meet the American Institute of Steel Construction Standards and yield maximum energy efficiency.

#### **Features**

- Floor area: 108,000 SF with a pre-approved expansion area of 216,000 SF; expandable up to 432,000 SF with additional Detailed Development Plan approval
- Dimensions: 300' x 360'
- Eave height: 38'
- Roof: 24-gauge standing seam metal roof, 8" vinyl faced batt insulated
- Floor: 4" dense grade aggregate; 8" concrete floor capable
- Walls: 24-gauge insulated sandwich panels and 8' block wainscot
- Foundation: Reinforced concrete
- Columns: Two rows with 40' x 100' spacing
- Docks: One drive-in door and two dock doors installed; expandable
