WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

CLASS I / STATE AGENCY MEMBERSHIP

Is available to cities and/or counties in California or any department or division of the state charged with the administration or enforcement of laws and ordinances relating to building construction.

TECHNICAL MEMBERSHIP
