PATCHOGUE ARTS COUNICL Call for Outdoor Sculptures for PAC MAC Festival October 2 -11, 2015

The Patchogue Arts Council is pleased to announce it is accepting submissions from sculptors to exhibit an outdoor sculpture in Patchogue Village during the **PAC MAC Festival**, a downtown centric, multi-day, multi-venue festival encompassing music, visual arts, and cinema. The PAC MAC Festival will run between the dates of October 2 – October 11, 2015 in Patchogue, NY.

Multiple sculptures will be installed in the **Patchogue Garden Club Garden** and **Roe Walkway**. Artists are encouraged to create an outdoor sculpture and will receive a stipend of up to \$750.00 for a newly created work if selected. Artists submitting an existing work will receive a stipend of up to \$300.00 if selected. The Visual Arts Committee of the Patchogue Arts Council will review all submissions. All artwork will be on view outside, in public spaces, and **must** abide by safety protocol and procedures.

- Email submissions due ON June 30, 2015
- Submissions received AFTER June 30, 2015 will not be considered
- Accepted artists will be notified through email by July 10, 2015

- Only submission to this email address will be considered

Email Submission Guidelines

- Please submit 2 images total of sculpture using the following specifications
- All files should be labels with your name and title of work. Ex: Yourname titleofwork.jpg
- If submitting a new work, include in your design plans: dimensions, a materials list, detailed budget, a 2 preparatory drawings, and a list of detailed installation instructions
- If submitting an existing work, please include 2 images of the work along with the dimensions, and detailed installation instructions
- The body of your email must include the image details: Title, medium, size, and date
- All artists must include: CV/resume, bio, artist statement.
- Submissions that do not follow ALL of the above guidelines will not be considered

Requirements & Restrictions

- Collaborations are permitted, but stipends are per sculpture not per artist
- There is no fee to submit work
- All artwork must survive unpredictable weather for two weeks
- Only digital submissions sent by June 30, 2015 will be considered
- Submissions must include images for existing work or proposal plans for new work

Important Information

- June 30, 2015: Submission Deadline: Submissions must be sent to PACMACFestivalSubmissions@gmail.com by this date
- **July 10, 2015: Artist Notifications** Artists granted public space to exhibit their sculpture will be notified via EMAIL by a Patchogue Arts Council representative.
- **September 24 October 1, 2015: Temporary Sculpture Installation –** Artists will be expected to install their sculpture between these dates
- October 2 October 11, 2015: Exhibition Dates PAC MAC Festival will be held in Patchogue, NY between these dates.
- October 12 October 16: Removal of Artwork Artists will be expected to retrieve their installation/sculpture between these dates.
