- Nominations close Friday, April 29, 2016. Winners will be announced at the time of the committee's decision.

AWARD CATEGORIES

Distinguished Philanthropist

Presented to an individual, couple or family who has demonstrated exceptional generosity in the art of giving both financial and leadership support to charitable nonprofit organizations. Nominees must have played a vital role in the greater Tarrant County community assisting nonprofit organizations to achieve their goals and fulfill their missions.

Outstanding Volunteer Fundraiser

Presented to an individual, couple or family who has impacted the greater Tarrant County community with exceptional leadership in major fundraising campaigns and projects benefiting a charitable organization. Nominees demonstrate leadership and organizational ability as well as value the importance of motivating others to join philanthropic causes.

Outstanding Youth in Philanthropy

This award recognizes service by an individual (age 5-23) who has demonstrated outstanding commitment to the community through direct financial support, development of charitable programs, volunteerism or leadership in philanthropy.

Outstanding Philanthropic Organization, Foundation/Trust, or Corporation

Presented to a Foundation, Trust, Corporation, Civic or Service organization that is committed to financially supporting charitable nonprofit organizations and charitable projects in the greater Tarrant County community affecting positively the lives or quality of life for area residents. They frequently motivate others to join them.

*This category will have up to three winners.

Outstanding Professional Fundraising Executive: The Ben Franklin Award

Presented to a fundraising professional in the Greater Fort Worth Metro area. The Ben Franklin Award is the award of distinction for fundraising professionals. Nominees demonstrate excellence in their knowledge and leadership skills in their organizations and the community in general.
