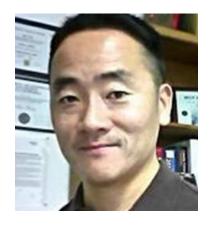

### Loyola Marymount University (LMU) Systems Engineering Leadership Program SELP 620 Quality Course

Offered in the fall from Aug. 29 – Dec. 9, 2016. Course registration is now open.

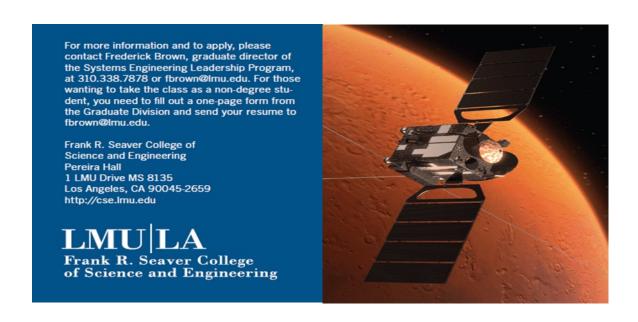
Course content: This course reviews the fundamental concepts that underlie the subject of managing for quality. The course presents the principles of product, processes and service quality. The body of knowledge and applied technologies include: development of quality systems, application and analysis of testing and inspection procedures, the ability to use statistical methods, familiarity with quality cost concepts and techniques, and how to establish quality improvement.

The SELP 620 course meets on Thursday evenings from 6 to 9 pm during the fall 2016 semester. The first class meeting will be Thursday, Sept 1. The last class meeting is on Dec 8, 2016.

The course can be taken as an individual course, as a non-degree student, without being accepted into the Certificate or MS degree in Systems Engineering program.

<u>Upon completion, this course can be counted toward a LMU Certificate in Systems Engineering or the eleven-course M.S. in Systems Engineering program if the student chooses to apply to and pursue those programs.</u>

The instructor holds a Doctor of Business Administration in Quality Systems Management and is a highly-regarded Quality professional with over 10 years experience teaching and training Quality to professionals including 3 years as an Adjunct Instructor at LMU.
