Treat your child to the summer adventure of a lifetime; a round-trip ticket to the Planet of Percussion. Guided by Canyon Records recording artist and seven-time GRAMMY® Nominee, Will Clipman, this high-energy hands-on workshop will channel all that pent-up youthful enthusiasm into a joyous exploration of world music rhythm and polyrhythm on a pan-global palette of exotic indigenous instruments. Students will orchestrate a musical composition, incorporating elements of intro and outro; verse, chorus and bridge; tempo and dynamics; and crescendo and diminuendo. Along the way, kids learn about the mathematics of music and the science of sound, and explore traditional techniques of drum construction and tuning, making the experience a truly interdisciplinary and multicultural journey around the Planet of Percussion. The workshop culminates with an informal community showcase presentation by the students: *The Planetary Players Percussion Ensemble!*
